NTRODUCTION



Dear readers,

As the year draws to a close it is time to take stock. Many of the measures in the coalition agreement to combat trafficking in human beings and violence against women have not (yet) been implemented. This is particularly true for the creation of a humanitarian right of residence for trafficked persons.

The KOK is calling for swift implementation and has made concrete proposals to politicians. The latest KOK data records on trafficking in human beings for 2022 shows a continuing high number of cases in the specialised counselling centres, with many clients from third countries. For these individuals, a humanitarian right of residence is paramount to enforce their rights to protection and support.

Germany's support for the tightening of European migration and asylum legislation is of particular concern, as it only increases the risk of vulnerable target groups falling prey to violence, trafficking in human beings and exploitation. KOK has been engaging closely with civil-society organisations across Germany and Europe and has taken part in campaigns calling for the enforcement of the human rights of refugees. On the 75th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, we cannot and will not look on as this key compass for the international community is eroded and nationalist and inhumane tendencies continue to gain ground.

However, there were also positive developments, such as the National Rapporteur on Trafficking in Human Beings taking up its work and the constructive discussions during the country visits of the Council of Europe Group of Experts on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings.

KOK is very grateful for the tireless commitment shown by all colleagues from our member organisations who do vital work day in, day out.

We would like to thank you, too, for your interest in our work and for your continued support.

A brief announcement for 2024: our international symposium on trafficking in human beings will take place on 26 and 27 September.

Our aim is and remains to combat trafficking and to enforce human rights.
